This letter is written to confirm that, to the best of our knowledge, Graduation Alliance is the only provider currently capable of operating a comprehensive, online Alternative Learning Experience program as defined by WAC 382-121-182 and a Dropout Reengagement Program as outlined in WAC 392-700.

Since 2007 Graduation Alliance has been operating as a virtual blended dropout recovery education program in partnership with more than 250 state agencies, school districts, community colleges, and workforce boards, serving over 25,000 students. Graduation Alliance's standard suite of services for dropout recovery is highly aligned to the requirements of WAC 382-121-182 and WAC 392-700, including:

- establishing satisfactory requirements for the monthly progress of students according to standards set by the customer.

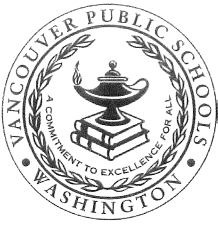
Overview

Our state-licensed teachers work with your students at a course level, while our mentors work with your students at a program level. All efforts are backed by our student services and support team and the systems we've built to run our own school.

Graduation Alliance is an online high school and educational services provider serving students in 43 states and 8 countries. The school has earned full regional accreditation from the Northwest Accreditation Commission, and offers more than 200 online courses, all supported by state-licensed teachers. We apply online learning to solve real problems faced by schools and school districts every day.
