RE: **SEESAW JUSTIFICATION FOR SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT**

Scope of Work

To support the district's strategic priorities, Seesaw will provide a digital portfolio for students in grades PreK-5 with 1:1 devices. Seesaw is the sole provider of a robust cloud-based K-5 digital portfolio, allowing students and teachers to document learning with various powerful built-in tools. Seesaw will enable students of all ages to add artifacts, draw, write, or add digital content providing accessibility options for all students. By allowing students to create a portfolio, families can view and stay informed of their student's progress in school. Seesaw also provides a valuable remote platform for students in grades PreK-5 when remote learning is the only option.

Minimum Requirements

Currently, Seesaw courses can be auto-rostered, allowing teachers to interact seamlessly with the students in their classes. Seesaw is the only developer making a product with these features in a digital portfolio platform. Students of all ages can quickly and efficiently add pictures, PDFs, videos, and voice recordings to their portfolio, making this a truly unique portfolio. Seesaw is the only PreK-5 digital portfolio system used for educational purposes.

Market Analysis

Vancouver Public Schools will continue to utilize the Seesaw digital portfolio for students in grades PreK-5. Seesaw is the sole provider of a digital portfolio that provides the features our students need to demonstrate their learning. The learning management system Canvas does have some of the features of Seesaw but does not provide the accessible functions for our youngest users. For the upcoming school year, purchasing Seesaw will provide a digital portfolio to students in grades PreK-5. Seesaw also plans to integrate with Canvas. By integrating with Canvas, Seesaw will provide a more uniform platform in grades PreK- 12th. Other platforms like Class Dojo allow students to submit assignments but focus more on behavior and not simply a portfolio for student work. After an elementary school pilot, the teachers of VPS found Seesaw to meet their and their student's needs successfully with a preferred parent communication platform.

Recommended Acquisition

It is recommended that Seesaw Learning Inc. and support services be purchased for a cost of \$64,496.00.

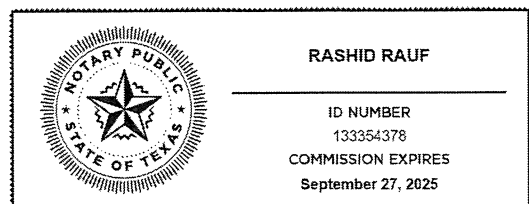
