| 1 gallon                | Salal Evergreen leaves, small urn shaped flowers on stalks, edible sweet purple berries. Moist or dry soils, in full sun or deep shade. It does have a harder time in full sun, but if well watered, it can survive. | 2             | \$5.00 |       |
| 1qt-1 gallon            | Assorted Perennials Shade plants, sun plants, and drought tolerant. All plants are native plant compatible and will not out compete our native plants.   | 20+           | \$2.50 |       |
| NATIVE SHRUI            | BS   |               |        |       |
| 1-5 gallon              | <b>Red Twig/Yellow Twig Dogwood</b> Colorful red or yellow twigs, good for stream bank planting and erosion control, white flower. Sunpart shade.  | 13            | \$4.00 |       |
| 1-5 gallon              | <b>Nootka Rose</b> Grows in a wide variety of sites, showy, solitary fragrant pink flowers. Sun-part-shade.  | 5             | \$5.00 |       |
| 1 -3 gallon             | <b>Clustered Wild Rose</b> Several clustered pink flowers at stem tips. Great for wet soils.   | 3             | \$5.00 |       |
