Vancouver Public Schools Final Recommendations for 2017-18 Budget

Highlights of Budget after Consensus State Budget

- Legislature funded K-3 class-size at 17 for all schools, per original McCleary plan (SHB 2776).
- State compensation increases, beyond 2.3% COLA, to decrease reliance on local levies were delayed until 2018-19 and 2019-20.
- Only other non-compensation enhancement in Basic Ed funding formula is MSOC inflationary increase (1.7%).
- Levy and levy equalization will be fully collected as a result of levy cliff delay bill (ESB 5023).
- Slight decrease in enrollment (expected in long-term demographer studies) largely offset with staffing adjustments.
- State will increase funding in LAP, Bilingual and Highly Capable programs.
