DELIVERY MODEL


- AA/BB cohorts

 - Online through VVLA (Leiser)






SCHEDULES





BUILDING PLAN HIGHLIGHTS: THOMAS JEFFERSON MIDDLE SCHOOL

School Entrance

- Students pass through main entrance
- Thermal camera takes temperature upon arrival
- Main entry will be monitored by staff





Passing Time

- Hallways marked with directional arrows
- Students travel in one-direction
- Staircases are designated "Up" and "Down"

BUILDING PLAN HIGHLIGHTS: DISCOVERY MIDDLE SCHOOL



Lunches

- 2 students per table or individual chairs
- Plexiglass divider
- 6 feet between tables
- Students move outside after eating
- 45 minutes between lunches for cleaning

Cleaning

- Student desks sanitized between periods
- Deep clean on Wednesday between student groups
- Electrostatic sprayer used in the evenings



BUILDING PLAN HIGHLIGHTS: FORT VANCOUVER CIS

The key is preparation, communication, and support

- <u>Training for staff</u>, (already started asynchronously)
- We will have two entrances with thermal cameras
- Experience from Small Group POD work
- Health Room Annex
- Training for staff and students both leading up to and after starting
- The goal is to be visible, consistent, and wise with established protocol implementation



BUILDING PLAN HIGHLIGHTS: COLUMBIA RIVER HIGH SCHOOL



- Teacher Training/ Staff orientations began January 20 with instruction
- Minimize procedural changes as we think about the possibilities of bringing more students on campus
- Establish predictable routines
- Focus on maximizing contact time
- Allow for flexibility in schedules that involve other magnets, Cascadia Tech & Running Start
