A desire for uniformity of practices and expectations

- Equity of experiences and accountability to teaching and learning across all schools, classes, and teachers.
- More video conferencing. Zoom was identified as the most popular remote learning tool and favored for touching base with students.

What We Will Do

To promote uniformity of practices and expectations

- Provide ClassLink as a single sign on solution and portal to house all learning applications
- Identify grade level core applications and platforms to minimize the number of digital learning tools used for remote learning experiences
- Use video conferencing (Zoom) for teaching and student “check-ins” on a regular basis
- Establish coherent and consistent practices and expectations to support and provide structure for remote learning
