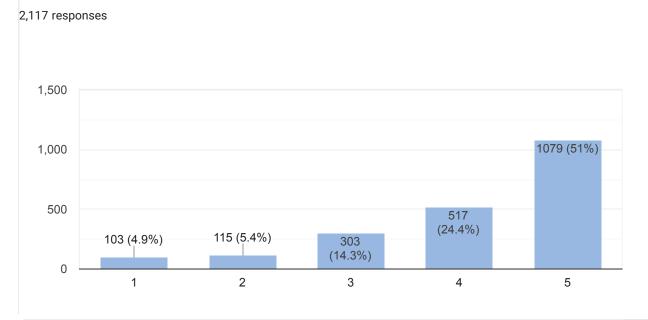

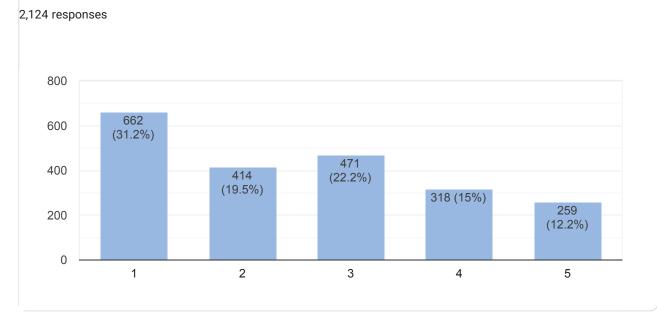

Reduce the number of central office administrators and district office staff



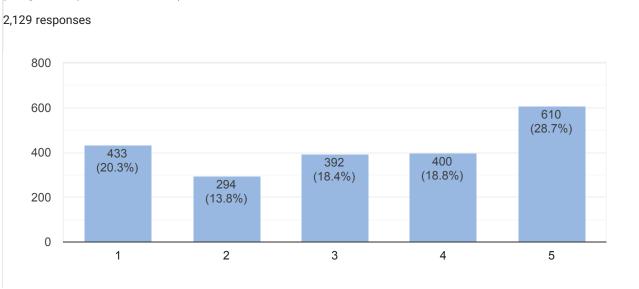
